Foliage

- Simple lanceolate leaves arranged in whorls along branches; typical of the species. New growth is light green and matures to a dark emerald green; smooth texture.



Habit

- 6 ft H x 5 ft W (+/-); if left unpruned, plants may grow larger
- Vigorous but responds well to pruning
- Zone 9-11; foliage will remain unharmed to temps in the high teens



Apps

- Water-wise Home Gardens
- Low Maintenance Streetscapes, Commercial Landscapes.
- Flowering Shrub (loads of flowers); uses: hedges, specimens, topiaries



Bloom

- Similar to the parent plant, 'Captain Cook': vivid, deep red bottlebrush inflorescence that are over 5 inches long.

MacArthur is the result of a controlled cross between two of the most successful Australian bottlebrush of all time: Callistemon 'Captain Cook' and C. 'Little John'. It was selected for its semi-dwarf size, vigorous growth and great flower habit. Simply put: it inherited the flower and vigor from 'Captain Cook' and a smaller stature from 'Little John', making it easy to grow yet well-behaved in the landscape.
