Foliage

- Small, rosemary-like leaves arranged in whorls along the branches. Young growth is typically gray-green but it matures to a dark emerald green with a smooth texture.



Habit

- 6 ft H x 5 ft W (+/-)
- Upright and freely branched growth habit. Vigorous growth rate yet responds well to pruning.
- Zone 9 -11; Evergreen in Zone 9b



Apps

- Water-wise Home Gardens
- Low Maintenance Streetscapes, Commercial Landscapes.
- Best suited to Western gardens but also adapt to the Southeast US.



Bloom

- Masses of VIVID violet-purple flowers, each about the size of a quarter, appear in small clusters along the stems, across the entire plant.

An improved coastal rosemary variety selected for one simple reason: it's flowers. In late winter/ early spring, plants will be completely covered with vivid purple flowers. Good for home gardens and commercial landscapes alike. Westringia are best suited to Mediterranean climates but Blue Gem exhibits notable adaptation to subtropic conditions of the southeastern United States.

Plant in well-drained soils with full to filtered sun. Irrigate deep and infrequently for best results.



FEATURES: drought tolerant, salt tolerant shrub with loads of small purple flowers.
