Foliage

• Rosemary-like leaves arranged in whorls along the branches. Pale gray-green foliage is highly glaucous which gives the plant an overall "gray" appearance.



Habit

- 1.5 ft H x 1.5 ft W (+/-)
- Round, "Box" Habit
- Slow to produce but establishes easily in the landscape.
- Zone 9 -11; Evergreen in Zone 9b



Apps

- Water-wise Home Gardens
- Low Maintenance Streetscapes, Commercial Landscapes.
- Best suited to Western gardens but also adapt to the Southeast US.



Bloom

- Snow-white, quarter-sized flowers that appear in small clusters along the stem, from late winter to summer and sporadically throughout the season.
