## Dianella Becca™



*Dianella caerulea* 'DCNCO' PP18,505 - One of the earliest improved selections of flax lily, selected because it does not have the tall canes normally associated with *Dianella caerulea*. Just as tough as the common form, only with a more compact and attractive habit which makes it ideal for commercial and highway plantings. Weeping foliage that slowly spreads by rhizomes. Best in full sun with light to moderate irrigation.



**Foliage:** • Grass-like foliage; bright green with a medium texture. Margins and midrib are serrulate (i.e. micro-serrations). Prune as needed; every 2-4 years.



**Habit:** • 2-2.5 ft H x 2 ft W; upright to arched foliage habit  
• Clumping to slowly spreading perennial  
• Zones 9b -11 for landscape applications; may also work in slightly colder regions if protected



**Apps:** • Mass, Group or Specimen Plantings  
• Water-wise Home Gardens  
• Streetscapes & Commercial Landscapes



**Bloom:** • Branched inflorescence appear in spring and sit just above the foliage, giving rise to dozens of small violet flowers with prominent yellow anthers.

**Notables:** • LIKES - Semi-regular irrigation, heat, and full sun

**Sales Niche:** • Drought tolerant foliage plant with unique color that is ideally suited to water-wise gardens & containers.



**CROP TIME:**

1-gal: 4-5 months from liners  
3-gal: 7-9 months from liners

\*depending on inputs & climate



**SALES STRATEGY:**

Sell as an evergreen ornamental grass; heat & drought tolerance, mean season-long sales appeal.



**LANDSCAPE NICHE:**

In Zones 9b and warmer, use as an evergreen "grass" for border, mass plantings, groupings, etc; home & commercial applications



**CONTAINER APP:**

Becca is best suited to landscape applications; likely grows too large for use in containers.
