**Dianella revoluta 'DR5000' PP18,452** - Architectural appeal, beautiful foliage and a tough demeanor; this flax lily is perfect for low water, low maintenance landscapes. Slowly spreads by rhizomes so it's great for mass plantings but with a little maintenance, Little Rev can be pruned to create a very nice specimen or group planting. Can develop a leaf spot in high humidity situations so Little Rev is best suited for Western gardens.



**CROP TIME:**

1-gal: 4-6 months from liners  
3-gal: 6-9 months from liners

\*depending on inputs & climate



**SALES STRATEGY:**

Sell as a low-maintenance groundcover; architectural habit & blue-green foliage translate to season-long retail appeal.



**LANDSCAPE NICHE:**

In mild Western climates, use as an evergreen, low-maintenance groundcover in full to filtered sun. Great for mass plantings!



**CONTAINER APP:**

Yes! Adds an architectural element to waterwise mixed containers and planters.



## Dianella Little Rev™



**Foliage:** • Narrow, sword-like foliage that is folded at the midrib; blue-green to gray-green. Color is more intense under dry conditions.



**Habit:** • 1.5-2 ft H x 1.5 ft W (+/-); shorter in full sun  
• Zone 8b-11; Evergreen in Zone 9 and warmer  
• Clumping to spreading perennial with an upright growth habit



**Apps:** • Group, Border or Specimen Plantings  
• Water-wise Home & Commercial Gardens  
• Spreading/rhizomatous habit makes this an ideal option for mass plantings & streetscapes



**Bloom:** • Clusters of small purple flowers with yellow anthers, borne on branched inflorescences that sit high above the foliage. Lighter bloom habit compared to other Dianella varieties.

**Notables:**

- LIKES - Infrequent irrigation, full sun, fertilizer
- DISLIKES - Overwatering, heavy shade, heavy soils

- In western climates: a low-maintenance & drought tolerant groundcover; great for mass plantings.
